

TREMPER HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

SCHEDULE:

Session 1 Gym – Monday June 18th through Friday July 06th (No School July 4th)

Session 2 Gym – Monday July 09th through Thursday July 26th.

Credit Recovery Classes will be from June 18th through July 26th. Students who finish their credits earned and are unable to acquire more credits will be released from Summer School with parent's permission.

All classes begin at 7:30 am and conclude at 12:00 pm with a 15 minute midmorning break.

ABSENCES:

Absences must be reported to the Summer School Office (262) 359-2213. Office hours are 7:15 am to 12:15 pm.

CREDIT RECOVERY/ATTAINMENT: ONLY 4 DAYS OF ABSENCES ARE ALLOW

Any absence after the 4th will result in the student being **DROPPED** from Summer School.

SUMMER GYM ABSENCES: ONLY 2 DAYS OF ABSENCES ARE ALLOWED:

Any absence after the 2nd will result in the student being **DROPPED** from Summer School. Also your letter grade could be affected by missing any Summer School Days and not making them up.

TARDIES:

If the student is late to class but not more than 30 minutes they will be marked tardy. If they are more than 30 minutes late to class they will be marked as ½ day absent. **2** tardies either at the beginning of the day or after the midmorning break will result in a ½ day absence. Again your letter grade will be affected by poor attendance.

DISCIPLINE:

Good behavior in the classrooms is essential and expected. Any student who received a disciplinary referral will put their summer school status in jeopardy. Tremper High School expects all students to act in an appropriate manner that is suitable for learning in the learning environment.

ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY INCLUDING DRESS CODE

In addition, the following will be enforced:

1. Students with cars must park in the EAST parking lot on the East side of the school. This is by the Ameche football field.
2. Students are not allowed to leave the building at any time unless they have been signed out through the Summer School office with a parent's permission. Being off campus without permission will result in a disciplinary referral and possibly being dropped from the Summer School programming.
3. No Smoking Allowed - A smoking violation will result in a disciplinary referral and the student being dropped from Summer School.
4. The use of any kind of drugs or alcohol during school hours or coming to school under the influence of a drug, including alcohol, will result in the student receiving a disciplinary referral, being dropped from Summer School, police contact, and a possible expulsion hearing.
5. Kenosha Unified School District Dress Code Policy remains in effect and is enforced. Including but not limited to; bottoms must be mid-thigh, shirts must have sides and no underclothing may be showing.
6. Students are encouraged to bring water bottles. They must be capped when they are near the computers. Eating is not allowed in the classroom. Students may eat during their break.
7. Tremper High School is not responsible for any loss or stolen items.
8. We will be selling snacks and cold drinks at breaks.
